



Visiting a friend

The teacher uses oral/written/sign language to describe the following story. Depending on the country, the names of the cities can be changed.

- George lives in Cyprus and Peter in Athens.
- George and Peter are best friends.
- They both wear hearing aids.
- They chat with each other.

The teacher asks the students to have a look at picture 1 on their handout.

- He and his parents arrive in the morning at the airport.
- The party will take place in the afternoon.
- The weather is very bad.
- There is a continuous delay of the flight.

- At the end, the flight is cancelled.
